**Re: NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL)
Streamlining Order XG/XO-100-2012
Notification of South Lateral Princess Control Valve**

In accordance with the Board's Streamlining Order XG/XO-100-2012, NGTL notifies the Board of upcoming work to install the South Lateral Princess Control Valve (Project) located 28 km northeast of Brooks, Alberta, with an estimated capital cost greater than \$1 million. Installation of the new control valve near the interconnection of the South Lateral and Eastern Alberta System Mainline is required to provide additional pressure on the 24-inch diameter South Lateral to provide reliable gas delivery to NGTL's customers. The requested on-stream date for the Project is November 15, 2013.

NGTL confirms that all interested parties have been notified of the proposed Project, and no issues or concerns have been raised, to date. Should any issues or concerns arise, NGTL will work with the interested parties to address them.

The South Lateral Princess Control Valve Project involves the installation of a pressure control valve station complete with a skid-mounted building, which will be located within the existing site of the Princess Compressor Station. The scope of work will include construction, onsite fabrication and commissioning of this system.	5.9	50.697142	-111.531923	September 9, 2013 to November 15, 2013

All work will take place within NGTL's existing right-of-way or compressor yard, and no new lands are required. There is no change in maximum operating pressure or the existing laterals.
