9. Potential impacts of the Project on Aboriginal interests.

The HCCC submit the following list of issues for determination:

- 1. Whether the NEB as presently constituted raises a reasonable apprehension of bias with respect to NEB's consideration of Haudenosaunee rights and interests;
- 2. Whether the NEB has breached section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982 and at the same time fiduciary duties by failing to establish an engagement process which upholds the honour of the Crown
 - a. If the NEB can proceed with a hearing on this matter where it is acting contrary to section 35 of the

- 3. Whether Natural Resources Canada has breached section 35 of the Constitution Act, fiduciary duties owed to the Haudenosaunee, and/or the treaty rights of the Haudenosaunee where it has purported to delegate engagement obligations to the NEB without undertaking any assessment of Haudenosaunee rights and interests which would determine the nature and scope of engagement required.
- a. If the NEB can proceed with a hearing on this matter as a question of law where it is acting contrary to section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982, breached fiduciary duties and/or failed to uphold the honour of the Crown
- 4. Whether NEB has breached section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982, fiduciary duties owed to the Haudenosaunee, and/or the treaty rights of the Haudenosaunee where it has purported to provide for engagement process without undertaking any assessment of Haudenosaunee rights and interests which would determine the nature and scope of engagement required.
- a. a. If the NEB can proceed with a hearing as a question of law where it is acting contrary to section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982, breached fiduciary duties and/or failed to uphold the honour of the Crown ("A")
- 5. Whether Natural Resources Canada and/or the NEB have breached section 35 of the Constitution Act, fiduciary duties owed to the Haudenosaunee, and/or the treaty rights of the Haudenosaunee where NRC and/or NEB have failed to consider whether the free prior and informed consent of the Haudenosaunee is required for the Project to proceed.
- a. If the NEB can proceed with a hearing on this matter as a question of law where it is acting contrary to section 35 of the Constitution Act, 1982, breached fiduciary duties and/or failed to uphold the honour of the Crown
- 6. Whether Natural Resources Canada and/or the NEB have breached section 35 of the Constitution Act, fiduciary duties owed to the Haudenosaunee, and/or the treaty rights of the Haudenosaunee where NRC and/or NEB have failed to consider an approach to Haudenosaunee rights and interests that is consistent with the Supreme Court of Canada decisions namely Grassy Narrows First Nation v. Ontario (Natural Resources), 2014 SCC 48, [2014] 2 S.C.R. 447 where it was held that the Crown must discharge fiduciary duties with respect to government activity that impairs or infringes treaty rights;
- 7. Whether the NRC can delegate engagement obligations which include fiduciary obligations;
- a.If the NEB can lawfully proceed with the hearing where NRC has unlawfully delegated fiduciary obligations
