



ORDER ROE-124-2016

IN THE MATTER OF the *National Energy Board Act* (the Act) and the regulations made thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF an application by Unipet America, Inc. (the Applicant), received 12 November 2015, for an Order pursuant to section 28 of the *National Energy Board Act Part VI (Oil and Gas) Regulations* (the Regulations), authorizing the exportation of oil, filed with the National Energy Board under File OF-EI-Oil-ST-U104 01.

BEFORE the Board on 27 November 2015.

WHEREAS the Board has considered the said application;

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Applicant is hereby authorized to export oil, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The term of this Order shall commence on 1 January 2016 and terminate on 31 December 2016.
2. Every contract or agreement entered into by the Applicant for the exportation of oil for a period exceeding one month shall contain a clause relieving the Applicant of the obligation to export to the extent that authorized exports are restricted by or under an Act of Parliament or a prerogative of the Crown.
3. The Applicant shall comply with:
 - i. the Act and any regulation made under it, and
 - ii. any order that applies to the Applicant made under the Act.
4. The Applicant shall file a report using the Commodity Forms web based system each month, not later than the last day of the next succeeding month to which the report relates. The report shall contain the information specified in section 7 of the *National Energy Board Export and Import Reporting Regulations*.
