## **ORDER ROE-168-2018**

**IN THE MATTER OF** the *National Energy Board Act* (the *Act*) and the regulations made thereunder; and

**IN THE MATTER OF** an application by SHIFT OIL CORP. (the Applicant), for an Order pursuant to sections 28 and 29 of the *National Energy Board Act Part VI (Oil and Gas) Regulations* (the Regulations), filed with the National Energy Board under File OF-EI-Oil-ST-S852 01.

**BEFORE** the Board on 12 July 2018.

**WHEREAS** the Applicant filed an application on 12 July 2018 for an order authorizing the exportation of light and heavy crude oil;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board has considered the application filed;

**IT IS ORDERED THAT** the Applicant is hereby authorized to export light and heavy crude oil, pursuant to sections 28 and 29 of the of the Regulations subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The term of this Order shall commence on 13 July 2018 and end on 31 December 2018.
- 2. Every contract or agreement entered into by the Applicant for the exportation of oil and/or refined petroleum products for a period exceeding one month shall contain a clause relieving the Applicant of the obligation to export to the extent that authorized exports are restricted by or under an Act of Parliament or a prerogative of the Crown.
- 3. The Applicant must comply with:
  - (a) the Act and any regulation made under it, and
  - (b) any order that applies to the Applicant made under the Act.
- 4. The Applicant shall file a report using the Commodity Forms web based system on or before the last day of each month, a return for the previous month. The report shall contain the information specified in section 7 of the *National Energy Board Export and Import Reporting Regulations*.
