**NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL)  
Wiau Lake North Sales Meter Station (the Project)**

The National Energy Board (Board) is a federal regulator that regulates pipelines and electrical transmission lines across Canada, specifically lines that cross provincial boundaries and the border into the United States. The Board is contacting you since your community may be impacted by a project for which the Board has received an Application.

On 11 June 2018, NGTL filed an Application with the Board regarding proposed construction and operation of a sales meter station. The proposed project is known as the Wiau Lake North Sales Meter Station (the Project). Attached to this letter you will find a summary of the Project, a project map, and NGTL contact information.

The Application is currently being reviewed by the Board and is publicly available on our website at [A92414](#)<sup>1</sup>. The Application includes details of NGTL's consultation with potentially affected Indigenous peoples for the Project. It also includes information from NGTL regarding any potential impacts the Project may have on Indigenous<sup>2</sup> interests, and any measures proposed by NGTL to address project-specific impacts.

Where a proposed project may potentially affect the interests or rights of Indigenous peoples, the Board requires companies to begin consultation activities early in the planning of a proposed project. This early consultation is aimed at both understanding how a project may affect Indigenous interests or rights and ways to mitigate any potential impacts. If the project is approved, company consultation must continue throughout construction, operation and abandonment phases.

- Your name, mailing address, phone number, and name of the person or group that you represent;
- Any concerns you may have about the Project and any comments with respect to potential impacts of the Project, including potential measures to address any impacts; and
- Any documentation and/or other submissions you feel explains or supports your letter

Should the Project be approved, conditions may be imposed to ensure any negative impacts will be mitigated or eliminated.

## **Wiau Lake North Sales Meter Station Project Summary**

NGTL is proposing to construct, own and operate a sales meter station to provide metering facilities for the measurement of sweet natural gas to meet a customer's incremental delivery transportation service contract. The Project will be located entirely on previously disturbed Provincial Crown land in NE 31-074-08 W4M and SE 06-075-08 W4M, approximately 21 km southwest of Conklin, Alberta. The Project will require the acquisition of approximately 0.64 ha of new land. Approximately 0.15 ha of temporary workspace is anticipated to be required for the construction of the Project.
