The Cowichan Tribes has a direct, local interest in the Project, its members being in possession and residents of Indian reserve lands located on Cowichan Bay and Cowichan River of southeast Vancouver Island. In addition, the Cowichan Tribes has demonstrable cases of Aboriginal rights (e.g. fishing) and title that stand to be impacted by the Project and possesses Aboriginal traditional knowledge that relates to the proposed Project area and the surrounding environs.

The construction and operation of the Project carries the potential to significantly impact Cowichan Tribes' asserted aboriginal rights and title, including but not limited to impacts to lands, water, fish, wildlife and related habitat, and leading to restricted harvesting access and safety issues faced by Cowichan Tribes members associated with Project-related and other marine tanker traffic on the relevant shipping routes which transect Cowichan traditional territory and travel corridors.

In the event of a tanker casualty in or about the Juan de Fuca Strait, the impacts on demonstrable Cowichan aboriginal rights and title will be disastrous, as the regulatory regime in place to address spills in waterways and marine accidents is wholly inadequate.
