We are counsel for the Stk'emlupseme to Secwepeme of the Secwepeme Nation ("SSN"), an affected Aboriginal group granted a detailed route hearing in the 2017 detailed route process as individual hearing number MH-014-2018. We write further to the Board's July 19, 2019 decision (the "Decision") on resuming regulatory processes related to the Project, specifically the detailed route approval process.

SSN intends to file a Statement of Opposition ("SOO") to the proposed detailed route and is awaiting personal service of the s. 34 notice from Trans Mountain pursuant to the Board's direction to Trans Mountain on page 4 of the Decision.
