- (c) the most appropriate timing of construction of the pipeline.

If you oppose the Trans Mountain Expansion Project Detailed Route, you <u>must</u> complete this form and file it within the 30 calendar day deadline, <u>regardless</u> of whether you submitted a Statement of Opposition in the 2017 TMEP Detailed Route process. See Parts E and F of this form.
