



ORDER TG-012-2020

IN THE MATTER OF the *Canadian Energy Regulator Act* (CER Act) and the regulations made thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF an application dated 29 February 2020 by Westcoast Energy Inc., doing business as Spectra Energy Transmission (Westcoast), which included consideration for an order from the Canada Energy Regulator (CER) pursuant to section 226 of the CER Act (Application) under File OF-Fac-Gas-W102-2019-05 02.

BEFORE the Commission of the CER (Commission) on 3 November 2020.

WHEREAS the CER received Westcoast's Application dated 29 February 2020 for the Silverstar Project (Project);

AND WHEREAS the Project includes adding metering capability at Westcoast's existing Sunset Creek Compressor Station (CS-16) to facilitate a planned new delivery point off its Transmission North (T-North) system at this location;

AND WHEREAS Westcoast is planning to install a series of meter runs that will be capable of measuring natural gas flows of up to about 34 10⁶m³/d (1.2 Bcf/d), along with auxiliary facilities including discharge piping, station isolation and pressure control valves, and other appurtenances;

AND WHEREAS Westcoast estimates the cost of the Project at approximately \$25 million;

AND WHEREAS the Application included a request for an order from the CER pursuant to section 226 of the CER Act affirming that the cost of the Silverstar Project will be included in the Transmission North (Zone 3) cost of service and tolled on a rolled-in basis;

IT IS ORDERED THAT, pursuant to section 226 of the CER Act costs required to provide service on the applied-for facilities will be included in the determination of the Westcoast T-North System revenue requirement, as approved from time to time by the Commission;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the tolls for services on the Project applied-for facilities will be calculated on a rolled-in basis using the same methodology that has been used to calculate tolls for services on all other facilities on the Westcoast T-North System, as determined through Commission order from time to time.
