- OGE Energy Resources, Inc. (the "Applicant"), a body corporate incorporated under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, U.S.A., hereby applies to the National Energy Board for an order authorizing it to import gas into Canada from the United States (the "Order"). This Application is made pursuant to subsection 15(b)(i) and section 16 of the National Energy Board Act, Part VI (Oil and Gas) Regulation.
- 2. The proposed term of Order is two years commencing on the 15th day of October, 2009 and ending on the 14th of day October, 2011.
- 3. The Applicant is the holder of NEB Order GO-84-2007, which commenced on the 15th day of October, 2007 and will end on the 14th day of October, 2009.
- 4. The gas to be imported pursuant to the applied-for Order will be acquired from numerous sources in the United States including producers, marketers and aggregators. The gas will be exported from the United States pursuant to DOE/FE Order No. 2466, being an order by the United States Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy granting blanket authorization to the Applicant to import and export natural gas from and to Canada (FE Docket No. 08-08-NG) issued on February 15, 2008.
