INAC INVOLVEMENT IN THE EA

With regard to environmental review of this project, Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) Alberta Region has decided that there is not a need for INAC to participate at this time. This decision is based on the preliminary information/map provided, where it appears that the project will not cross any reserve lands or have direct impact on reserve lands, and that INAC will not be performing any regulatory or permitting function.

CONSULTATION RELATED INFORMATION

Please be advised that Aboriginal groups in the area may have interests in the project and its proposed environmental and socio-economic impacts. The specifics of the project may require an assessment of those interests. We encourage proponents and federal departments and agencies issuing authorizations, permits, etc. to make reasonable efforts to ensure First Nations and Métis groups that may have an interest in the project are given the opportunity to become involved in the project review process.

Please note that INAC does not act as a representative for any Aboriginal group for the purpose of any claim or consultation. It is up to proponents and those that may have a legal duty to consult to decide which groups to engage, and how to engage them. To assist you in identifying these Interests and groups, we have attached a list of information sources and contacts.

Based on preliminary review by regional lands and claims staff, and the Litigation Management and Resolution Branch of INAC, INAC:

- is not aware of any land claims affecting the project area;

And

- Is aware that the project <u>area</u> may be the subject of litigation filed by Individuals acting on their own behalf and on behalf of the Kelly Lake Cree Nation.

Additionally, the Office of the Federal Interlocutor for Métis and Non-Status Indians (OFI) is aware that the Métis Nation of Alberta and its president, Audrey Poltras, have asserted a Métis right to harvest across the province. Should the proponent decide to pursue its investigation further, this would be the organization to contact in order to obtain further assistance when deciding if there is a rights-asserting Métis community in the project area. 
