Re: Trans Mountain Pipeline ULC
Identification of Pipe and Fittings with Potential to Exhibit Substandard Material Properties

Trans Mountain Pipeline ULC (“Trans Mountain”) is in receipt of National Energy Board’s (the “Board”) Order MO-001-2016, which requires companies who hold regulatory authorization to construct and operate a pipeline regulated by the Board to provide information with respect to pipe and fittings with the potential to exhibit substandard material properties.

Trans Mountain has commenced a detailed file review, which involves the identification, retrieval and analysis of records (most of which are offsite). Given the volume of capital projects Trans Mountain has completed, this is a sizable undertaking. For this reason, Trans Mountain will not be in a position to provide a response to the five (5) requests for information identified in Order MO-001-2016 within 60 days, as required. Accordingly, Trans Mountain respectfully requests an extension to 30 September 2016 to provide its response to the requests for information.
